Areas of Redundancy

This graphic shows areas of redundancy between Thoreau Farm and Thoreau Society largely necessitated by their being separate legal entities. YELLOW CIRCLES show the work of Thoreau Farm and BLUE CIRCLES show the work of Thoreau Society. Close collaboration (shown as overlapping circles) affords some efficiencies (areas of GREEN.) RED CIRCLES show additional work created by separate legal entities coordinating their work. A new, merged organization would significantly reduce these redundancies, therefore streamlining and strengthening our functions. In many areas, it would reduce the amount of time and energy spent by more than 50% and free up resources to devote to mission-driven goals. Some areas (shown as incomplete overlapping circles) would still require separate resources (e.g. the Shop and Farmhouse as distinct locations will continue to have distinct needs.)
